What is APLHA...

ALPHA is a place to explore the Christian faith with others. It's a series of videos and conversations focused on the questions of life, faith, and meaning. Each session includes a time to connect with others, hear a talk on some element of faith, and then a chance for people to share their own questions and perspectives with the group. If you want to just listen that's ok too. We create a non-judgmental and open environment where it's easy for anyone who is atheist, skeptic, or simply curious about faith to explore questions of life with new friends.

Who to invite...

People like be invited to things because it makes them feel wanted. Invite people you want to share your ALPHA experience with. Invite them to join you in this journey. Sure, there's some risk of them saying no but that's ok. Just inviting them is a good step in showing someone you care about them.

- You can invite anyone. There are no geographic boundaries.
- Consider inviting your brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, grandparents or grandchildren
- Maybe there's someone in your office building or in an association you are part of. Invite them. Maybe there's a staff person where you work. Maybe you work with someone online because of the pandemic. Send them an e-mail or give them a call. Invite your coworkers.
- Invite a neighbor.
- Invite the person who hands you your cup of coffee from the coffee shop.
- Invite someone who looks like they need help
- BIG PICTURE...people appreciated being thought of and invited to something. Show them you care.

In-person invitation considerations

- 4 main points:
 - 1.) Tell them your church is offering an online event called ALPHA
 - 2.) ALPHA is a chance for people to discuss and explore life and the Christian faith in a small group environment. It's an opportunity for people to have fun while creating and building meaningful relationships.
 - 3.) It's a non-judgemental and open environment for people to watch videos and discuss the topics of the videos.
 - 4.) Ask them if they would like to do ALPHA online with you and if not offer to send them more information.
