

History

1887 - Frank Bren gifted the land for the church building and cemetery. The Church was organized as the Bohemian Evangelical Church of Deephaven Junction.

1900 - The congregation becomes Presbyterian and is renamed the Bohemian Presbyterian Church.

1933 – A fire destroyed the entire church structure and all its contents, including the church and cemetery records. It was rebuilt in 1934. By examination of headstones, burial records were reconstructed.

1939 - The Bohemian Presbyterian Church is renamed the John Hus Presbyterian Church, and the cemetery named John Hus Cemetery.

1968 - Glen Lake Presbyterian Church merges with John Hus Church and the congregation is named Faith Presbyterian Church.

2010 - Peace Garden installed

2012 - 125th Anniversary of Faith Presbyterian Church and Faith Cemetery.



Governance

Faith Cemetery is part of the Faith Church 501(c)3 corporation. The trustees operate the cemetery as a public cemetery and according to Minnesota Statutes.

The Faith Cemetery Handbook includes Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, and Policies of Operation. Please contact the church office or a cemetery trustee to receive a copy.

Rite of Burial

Rite of Burial fees (plot fee and grave maintenance) are paid to Faith Church Cemetery. Cemetery trustees transfer a deed to the owner when full payments are received.

Interment Cost

Interment costs are set by the trustee-designated service provider. Costs are subject to change. A trustee will have contact information for you at time of burial.

Markers

The Rite to burial includes a request that a marker is installed within one year of interment. Plot marker specifications as documented in the cemetery handbook are strictly enforced. Please contact the Church office for further information.

Operations

- Cemetery hours are 7 a.m. to Sunset.
- No pets allowed.
- Plants and flowers must be in pots on above ground stands.
- Summer flowers allowed beginning May 1st and must be removed, along with the pots, before October 15th.
- Winter arrangements allowed beginning October 15th and must be removed by May 1st.
- Easter plants allowed one week before and one week after Easter.
